all have sin — we do and say and think things that break God's laws and make Him sad — that we all will die. Our bodies will all die, and our souls also will die, forever away

from God, who made us and loves

- But God loves us, and just like

- Peter went to find Tabitha and made her alive, Jesus, the Son of God, came to find us and make us alive! - Jesus died instead of us for our sins! And Jesus then came back to life so that when we believe in Jesus, we can have forever life with
