The book of Acts tells the story of how the Gospel of Jesus spread throughout the world of the first century A.D. — and one man (Paul)

century A.D. — and one man (Paul) was especially instrumental in that effort. Paul not only traveled on multiple journeys speaking the Gospel and starting new churches,

but he also wrote letters to many of those new congregations.

The Bible includes 13 of those letters! (Find a chart of all 13 letters **here**!) As we continue our study in Acts, our midweek studies occasionally will focus on one of those letters (also called epistles).
